Fellow pilots,

In our last message to the pilot group on Friday, May 5, 2017, we communicated that the Company has accused the Association and Spirit pilots of instigating a concerted action to disrupt its operations by discouraging pilots from picking up open time flying or accepting junior assignments. We also notified you that the Company might seek emergency relief in federal court to restore its operations. Please be assured that the SPA MEC has been working closely with ALPA National and we are prepared for any legal action that might be brought by Spirit Airlines. We will actively defend our organization, its officers, and members and will inform you if the Company files a lawsuit against us.

It is important to reiterate that neither our Union nor this MEC is sponsoring a job action of any sort. The decision to pick up open time is your own, but we are not asking anyone to turn down flying and believe that pilots who do pick up additional flying are helping, not hurting, matters. We again ask you to do everything possible to help restore Spirit's operations.
